He is adjunct professor in the lingual technique at Ferrara University and adjunct professor at Complutense University Madrid. He is also director of the First International Master in Lingual orthodontics at Ferrara University and Co-Director of the PG Program in Lingual Orthodontics at the Complutense University of Madrid and teacher at Master Advanced Study Lingual Ortho, Basel University Swiss.

Dr. Scuzzo has presented and published extensively in Italy and abroad on lingual orthodontics and published 70 article about this technique. He also published, with Dr. Takemoto, 3 books about lingual orthodontics, translated in 6 languages.

Dr. Scuzzo has a private practice limited to lingual orthodontics in Rome, Italy
